In order to complete the admissions process for our Bridge program, the following items will need to be completed and submitted to the Admissions Office no later than the priority deadline to ensure a smooth transition. *Please ask the Admissions Office for the priority deadline date for the upcoming semester.*

Required Items

1. Bridge Application

- Student will need to declare a major on the Bridge Application.
- Student will be required to submit photo identification (Ex: Passport, Visa, Driver's License, etc....)

2. Reference

- Personal Reference Form (*Employer, supervisor, teacher, friend, commanding officer, other*)

3. Letter of Proficiency (*Provided by ESL Coordinator*)

4. Official Transcript

- Official transcript (*submit one of the aforementioned items*):
 - o Official high school/Secondary school transcript
 - o Passing GED test scores or
 - o A conferred Associate Degree from an accredited institution
- Submit through the following methods:

Once complete, please submit all documents in one email to admissions@beulah.edu.

Following the receipt of all documents, the Admissions Committee will review all files and notify the student within **7-10** business days.
