



STEP-BY-STEP DOCTOR OF MINISTRY ADMISSIONS PROCESS

*Please send all documents from Steps 1, 2, and 3 to admissions@beulah.edu once they are ready for submission

[] Step 1. Application & Proof of Identification

- ❖ Submit the following:
 - Application – Complete online at www.beulah.edu/applynow or use downloadable application
 - Application fee - \$100.00 (*non-refundable*)
 - Proof of Identification – Driver’s License, Identification Card, or Passport

[] Step 2. Reference Form

- ❖ Submit the following:
 - Personal Reference Form - The reference form must be completed by a non-family member who has known the student for longer than six months at least.

[] Step 3. Writing Sample

- ❖ Demonstration of basic research, writing, and critical thinking skills by submission of a graduate-level research paper. Submit a 5-10 page research-oriented writing sample.

[] Step 4. Transcript

- ❖ An MDiv degree or equivalent (see MDiv Equivalency Template) indicating sufficient preparatory work for advanced work in the area of study is required for admission. The student’s GPA in this degree must ordinarily be at least 3.0 on a four-point scale.
- ❖ Submit through the following methods:
